PAR AND YARDAGE

Jefferson City Country Club will be set up at 6,982 yards for the two qualifying rounds. JCCC will play to a par of 36-36—72. The golf course will be stretched out to 7119 yards for Match Play Portion of Championship.

ARCHITECT Jefferson City Country Club first opened for play in 1922. Originally a nine hole venue, a Larry Packard-designed second nine was added in the 1960s. The golf course was closed from July 7, 2008 to May 23, 2009 for complete greens reconstruction, rerouting of a few holes, and bunker reconstruction. All 18 existing "push-up" greens were rebuilt to USGA specifications. The old Penncross bentgrass and poa annua turf was replaced with modern A-series bentgrass. Nine greens were relocated and re-contoured to improve playability and increase cupping space. The work was done by the design team of Bob and Matt Lohman. The renovation has stretched the private layout to around 7,100 yards from the tips.

ENTRIES

The Missouri Golf Association had 350 amateurs attend 1 of 5 different golf courses around the state to attempt to qualify for the 2016 Missouri Amateur Championship.

LOCAL QUALIFYING

Local qualifying played 18 holes, was conducted at 5 sites in between May 27-June 15.

CHAMPIONSHIP FIELD The championship field will consist of 147 golfers.
