MGA Hall of Fame

The MGA board of directors nominates players into the Hall at the annual June meetings. In November a two-thirds vote is necessary for entry into the Hall of Fame. Since 2009 induction ceremonies have been held the following June at the site of the Missouri Amateur.

- 2. Distinguished service to the game of golf in the state of Missouri
- 3. A distinguished professional career after playing in the Missouri Amateur
