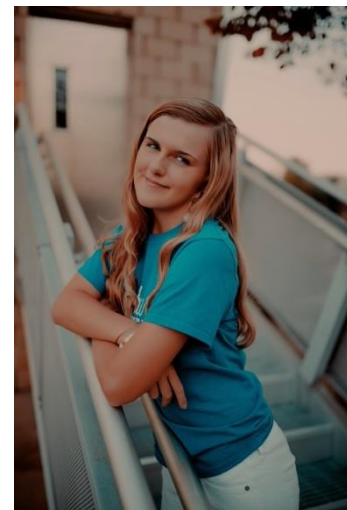
Reese Hamilton
