# Missouri Golf Association Missouri Junior Tour Events

## **Eligibility Requirements**

- Gender: Open to male and female golfers of all skill levels
- Membership: Players must be a member of the Missouri Junior Tour (\$50)
- **Age:** 8-18 as of June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025. (Younger players may request to play up email Reese Hamilton: rhamilton@mogolf.org)
- Must live in Missouri or a contiguous state

## **Registration Information**

Players can register for all MJT events starting on March 4, 2025 at 9 a.m. All registrations close **7 days prior to the event at noon.** The Junior Tour is very popular among our members, so we encourage you to register for your desired events as soon as possible.

If the event is full when you register, you will automatically be put on the waitlist. You will not be charged for the event until a spot becomes available.

## **Divisions and Yardages**

A player will compete in the age division based on their age as of **June 3, 2025**. This date will determine your age division placement for the entire 2025 Missouri Junior Tour season.

### 9-hole divisions

8-9 girls & boys: fairway tees (approx. 1500 yards) (parents/guardians can use a cart to drive players)

**10-11 boys:** 2300-2600 yards **10-13 girls:** 2300-2600 yards **12-13 boys:** 2300-2600 yards

**14-15** girls: 2300-2600 **18-Hole Divisions** 

**12-13 boys:** 5200-5600 yards **14-15 girls:** 5000-5400 yards **15-15 boys:** 5800-6200 yards **16-18 girls:** 5200-5600 yards **16-18 boys:** 6,000 – 6500 yards

\* 14-15 girls and 12-13 boys can choose if they play 9 or 18 holes. For the 14-15 girls, we recommend 18 holes if her scores average 100 or lower, and 9 holes for 100 or higher.

# **Entry Information**

- **Deadline:** Must register online by noon 7 days prior to each event
- Fee: 9 holes: \$35; 18 holes: \$55
- Field size: 90 players
- Format: 9 or 18 holes of gross stroke play
- **Refund Policy:** Refunds are issued if requested at least 7 days prior to start of event. Refunds are not issued if requested less than a week in advance.

All tournaments will begin no later than 8 a.m. Tee times and other information will be emailed to all players no later than 3 days prior to the event.

- Range balls may or may not be included in entry fee (based on course decision)

## Caddies

• Caddies are not permitted during this event **except** for players in the 8-9 age division

- Spectator cart fees: Differ based on course (will be sent out in player information email 3 days prior to event.
- Players are not allowed to ride in a spectator's golf cart at any time

#### **Event Attire**

- Appropriate golf attire is required at all MGA events. Appropriate golf attire for men includes a collared shirt
  with sleeves that must always be tucked in and Bermuda length shorts or slacks. Proper golf attire for
  women consists of a shirt with sleeves or a collared tank top, paired with a skirt, shorts, or slacks. Shoes
  with metal or traditionally designed spikes must NOT be worn.
- In the event of any conflicts between the dress code as outlines by either the MGA or the host facility/venue, the dress code of the host facility/venue will prevail.
- Failure to adhere to the MGA attire policy may result in the player being asked to change or leave the event.
