- Open to amateur golfers with an active GHIN number at a Missouri Golf Association member club and/or who reside in the state of Missouri.

- Deadline: Must register online by noon on June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2025
- Fee: \$130
- Field size: 150 players
- Format: 36 holes of stroke play qualifying, cut to top 16 in each division.
- Divisions: Boys 14-18 approx. 6200 yards
   Girls 14-18 approx. 5600 yards
- **Refund Policy:** Refunds are issued if requested at least 7 days prior to start of event. You will receive the entry fee minus a \$30 processing charge. For this event you can receive a refund of **\$100** if requested by **June 2**<sup>nd</sup>, **2025**. Refunds are not issued if requested less than a week in advance.

## **Cart/Range Fees**

- Practice round cart fee TBD
- Carts are **NOT** permitted during the championship
- Range balls are included in the entry fee

#### **Caddies**

- Caddies are not permitted during the qualifying rounds of stroke play.
- Players may have a caddie during the match play rounds. Caddies can **NOT** be a parent or parental figure.

#### **Spectators**

- Players are not allowed to ride in a spectator's golf cart at any time

#### **Event Attire**

- Appropriate golf attire is required at all MGA events. Appropriate golf attire for men includes a collared shirt
  with sleeves that must always be tucked in and Bermuda length shorts or slacks. Proper golf attire for
  women consists of a shirt with sleeves or a collared tank top, paired with a skirt, shorts, or slacks. Shoes
  with metal or traditionally designed spikes must NOT be worn.
- In the event of any conflicts between the dress code as outlines by either the MGA or the host facility/venue, the dress code of the host facility/venue will prevail.
- Please note this policy is in effect for both players and caddies without exception.
- Failure to adhere to the MGA attire policy may result in the player being asked to change or leave the event.

Medals/Trophies will be given to the top finishers of each division following the conclusion of play

- The 25<sup>th</sup> Missouri Boys Junior Match Play Champion will earn an exemption to the US Junior Amateur Championship
- The 25<sup>th</sup> Missouri Girls Junior Match Play Champion will earn an exemption to the US Girl Junior Amateur Championship

- This is a point event for the Female and Male Junior Player of the Year standings
- This is a point event for Junior Girls Four State and Southern Junior Cup standings
- This is a Junior Golf Scoreboard Ranked event, WAGR Ranked event, and AJGA stars event
