- Membership: At least one player must have an MGA Membership (\$40)
- Age: No age restrictions
- USGA Handicap Index: At least one player must have an up-to-date USGA Handicap Index
- Must live in Missouri or a contiguous state

Entry Information

- **Deadline:** Must register online by noon on July 21st, 2025
- Fee: \$475 per team
- Field size: 160 players, 80 teams
- **Format:** Two days of 18-hole scramble competition; Highest division is two days of 6-6-6
- **Divisions:** Open Division Based on handicaps, teams will be divided into 6-6-6 division and 4 other scramble divisions.

Century Division – Teams with a combined age of 100 or more. (This flight completes against each other).

Super Senior Division – Teams with one player 70 or older. (This flight completes against each other).
