- Membership: No membership required
- Age: 6-13 as of July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2025
- Open to amateur golfers with an active GHIN number at a Missouri Golf Association member club and/or who reside in the state of Missouri.

- Fee: \$70
- Field size: 150 players
- **Format:** Male and females ages 6-8: 18-hole stroke play competition Male and females ages 9-13: 36-hole stroke play competition
- Divisions: Boys: 6-8: 1500 yards (9-holes per day)

9-11: 4700 yards (18-holes per day)

12-13: 5200 yards (18-holes per day)

Girls: 6-8: 1500 yards (9-holes per day)

9-11: 4700 yards (18-holes per day)

12-13: 4700 yards (18-holes per day)

Refund Policy: Refunds are issued if requested at least 7 days prior to start of event. You will receive the entry fee minus a \$30 processing charge. • Players may have caddies at this event, but they must NOT be over 18 years of age.

#### **Event Attire**

- Appropriate golf attire is required at all MGA events. Appropriate golf attire for men includes a collared shirt with sleeves that must always be tucked in and Bermuda length shorts or slacks. Proper golf attire for women consists of a shirt with sleeves or a collared tank top, paired with a skirt, shorts, or slacks. Shoes with metal or traditionally designed spikes must NOT be worn.
- In the event of any conflicts between the dress code as outlines by either the MGA or the host facility/venue, the dress code of the host facility/venue will prevail.
- Please note this policy is in effect for both players and caddies without exception.
- Failure to adhere to the MGA attire policy may result in the player being asked to change or leave the event.
