100 Years Ago 1926

Jimmy Manion became the first player to win four Missouri Amateurs at Westborough in St. Louis. Also a record at the time was the 38 holes it took him to defeat Clarence Wolff.

50 Years Ago 1976

At age 53, Jimmy Jackson defeated Dennis Goettel (22) at St. Joseph CC. Jackson's record remains as the oldest Missouri Amateur champion. His Walker Cup career spanned five decades, 1942-1981.

25 Years Ago 2001

At Sunset CC in St. Louis, two time winner Mark McBride defeated two-time Kansas Am champion Len Johnsen, Jr. in 37 holes. McBride rallied from four down with eleven to go.

10 Years Ago 2016

Sam Migdal defeated Hunter Parrish at Jefferson City CC, 1 up. Mizou player Luigi Botta of Cuneo, Italy was the medalist at 4 under par.

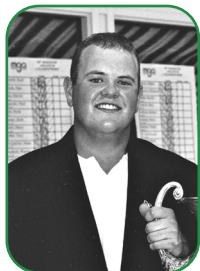

The 1907 Missouri Am was also played at St. Louis CC. It was won by Albert Lambert, namesake of the St. Louis airport, Lambert Field.

The Missouri Amateur returned to Milburn for the sixth time, but the first since 1994. As in 2025, two young medalists shared the honor, Stone Yerrington (19) and Harrison Zipfel (18).

By the quarterfinals only 2016 runner-up Hunter Parrish (33), Tony Gumper (45) and

Connor Knabe (31) were older than 21.

The final started off with Parrish sending his wedge shot over the green and out of bounds. Both the UMSL golfer Logan Mayo (20) and Parrish went up by two, then down by two before Parrish squared the match on the 35th

hole. It took Parrish's par on the second extra hole to win the championship. He thus avenged his 2016 championship loss to Sam Migdal in the finals, 1 down after 36 holes.

Hunter won an exemption into this year's U.S. Amateur tournament.

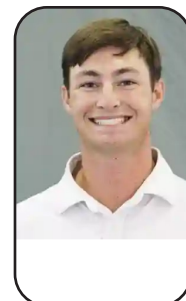

The Missouri Amateur was played in central Missouri for the 7th time. Jefferson City CC five times, Columbia twice.

Stroke play qualifying was dominated by youth. Two college players who were foreign-born led the qualifying at 7 under par. The 2024 runner-up, Presten Richardson was one shot behind and four-time

champion Brad Nurski, 47, was two shots back.

Perhaps the story of the week was 15-year-old Anson Munzlinger of Columbia. Fifth in qualifying, Anson won four matches before losing in the semifinals.

47-year-old Brad Nurski also made a valiant effort to win his 5th Missouri Amateur

before losing in the semifinals.

In the final it was 44-year-old Chad Niezing of St. Louis edging 22-year-old Hunter Jowers of Jonesboro, Ark. and the Drury golf team.

Niezing claimed his second Missouri Amateur championship. His first was in 2022 at Bellerive CC.

Miriam Burns (Horn) Tyson (1904-1951)

At the age of 16, young Miriam Burns won the first of her many golf championships. In an era when all golfers played from the same tees, she set numerous course records throughout the Kansas City area, often battling fellow Hall of Fame honoree Opal Hill in city, regional and national tournaments.

The young Ms. Burns honed her game under the guidance of Milburn Head Professional Harry Robb Sr.

She won **seven Kansas City Women's Match Play** titles between 1920 and 1929, won the **Trans-Miss championship in 1927** and the **Women's Western Amateur in 1923 and 1930**. She also won two Missouri Women's Amateurs in this time.

Traveling the country, winning tournaments from California to New York, the by-then-married and divorced Mrs. Horn drew national attention to Kansas City, especially during her successful march to the **1927 Women's US Amateur Championship** where she defeated renowned amateur Maureen Orcutt (5&4) in the final. It was held at the Cherry Valley Club, Garden City, New York.

Mrs. Horn was the first USGA Women's Champion from west of the Mississippi River and something of a celebrity, often followed by large galleries wanting to see what sportswriter O.B. Keeler called the "IT Girl" of women's golf.

As did Bobby Jones in 1930, at the age of 26, she retired from competitive golf. After traveling the world with her second husband George Tyson, Miriam died of pneumonia at the age of 47 in Kansas City at 209 East 47th Street, on the Plaza.
